The takeaways from "Carbon Markets and Decarbonising Industries" Replacing fossil fuels with Green Hydrogen vis-a-vis India:

- 1 Green Hydrogen produced by electrolysis using renewable energy instead of thermal power for green and blue hydrogen
- 2 Cost of producing green hydrogen in India Rs 350/kg as compared to blue/green hydrogen Rs 160/kg
3. Adaptability in the automobile industry
4. Producing steel thru use of green hydrogen. In Oman steel is produced by use of green hydrogen i.e 140 million MT hydrogen is required to produce 2.5 million MT of steel
5. Target is to produce Hydrogen at a cost of 1 dollar /tonne
6. Constraint: Hydrogen being a lighter gas produces a cooling effect in the blast furnace of steel plants

On 04.07.25, a delegation of AIACE Nagpur branch consisting of Shri B.G.Bahoria, Sri M Ashok Kumar, Sri B.A.Raghorste and Sri Rajmal Verma visited WCL (HQ), Nagpur and met Dr. Hemant S. Pande, D (P-HR), WCL and Sri A. S. Mhetre, CVO, WCL and wished them for a very happy and prosperous New Year.

The delegation took the opportunity to felicitate D(P/HR) and CVO, WCL by presenting Bouquet, Memento (10th Foundation Day-AIACE Nagpur branch and Booklet (AIACE-Nagpur branch), released on 18th May-2025 during "Foundation Day celebrations held at WCL HQ -Sanskratik Bhavan, Nagpur. The team had a

fruitful discussion with D(P/HR) regarding CPRMSE Medical Bills, Medical Cards and Life Certificate etc. He told that the time for payment of Medical bills will be gradually reduced from one month to one week and finally same day after the submission of bills, for which action is in process. Gold Cards will be further replaced by Chip Cards in which most of the relevant updated realtime information on CPRMSE. The work in this regard is in process.



The Team members also requested D (P) to allow empanelled hospitals for availing ayurvedic treatment. He informed that in a month or two, WCL is going to take necessary action in this regard for empanelment. Further he informed that WCL is going to open medical store in Nagpur and in two other areas of WCL where medicines will be available at very cheap rates.

D(P) further informed that, in near future, PRMB cell, which now looks after medical cases only, will be made a "one window cell" for dealing with medical, pension and PF cases of retired employees.

Lastly, the delegation drew his attention to change the offline system of submission of Life certificates as followed by CIL. He assured to make above change to follow Online system. It is hoped that some drastic change may be seen about CPRMSE in near future.
