Sub: Combining Life Certificate with Family certificate in Physical Mode and need to design similar Family Certificate in Digital mode

Dear Sir,

It is a matter of great satisfaction that steps have been initiated for starting hassle-free starting of widow/widower pension as a result of our continuous efforts and a successful meeting on 5-3-2021 was held in New Delhi in the chamber of Sri A. Bharti, Economic Advisor, Ministry of Coal, Govt. of India.

In this connection your recent Press release dt. 13-8-2021 on SIMPLIFICATION OF PENSION DISBURSEMENT THROUGH —SUNIDHI underlines various measures taken in this regard. Accordingly, a revised PPO form is under development and a new format of Life certificate has been developed from which the disbursing bank will collect the data and send to all Regional Offices for necessary check and upload in SUNIDHI.

This new Life certificate differs from the old Life certificate because the pensioner has to submit self data as well as spouse's name and Aadhar number to the bank. This provision has made it easier for the pension disbursing banks to collect data of spouses more conveniently, but at the same time, it has deprived the pensioners who opt for digital mode of Jeevanpramaan for Life certificate submission. There is no way to collect spouses data in Jeevanpramaan.

So it is requested to evolve a design for online submission of spouses data, in absence of which the digital mode of Life submission becomes useless for all practical purposes and such pensioners are bound to suffer.
