Sub: Meagre Pension to pensioners in coal sector due to apathetic attitude of CMPF and Ministry of Energy in revising pension stagnant for 23 years

Dear Sir,

We want to bring to your kind notice the problems being faced by retired executives and employees of Coal India and Singareni Collieries Company Ltd. and appeal to you to initiate a suitable action for enhancement of pension.

Presently, under CMPS 1998, a fixed amount of pension is paid to coal Pensioners by Coal Mines Provident Fund Organization (CMPFO) and no revision has been done in last 23 years although there is a provision of review of the scheme after every three years and revision thereof. Functioning under Ministry of Coal, CMPFO has belied all expectations to solve this ailing issue and probably failed to manage the fund.

We are thankful to Secretary, Coal who was kind enough for arranging a meeting with coal ministry officials in the month of March, 2021. In the meeting, we were asked to submit our proposals for carrying out enhancement of pension for coal employees. Accordingly, vide letter no. AIACE/CENTRAL/2021/ 25 dated 11.3.2021, we submitted the same but still there is no light at the end of tunnel. All the relevant documents are with the authorities, but the will to address the issue is seemingly absent.

We request your kind intervention in this matter so that the upward revision in pension is ensured to these pensioners without any further delay by concerned authorities.
