Sub:- Non-payment of OPD-cum-Domiciliary treatment reimbursement by Subsidiaries for Half-year ending 31st December 2021

Dear Sir,

Your attention is requested to be drawn to the fact that many of our member executives (Retd.) of AIACE, being covered under CPRMSE, have not been so-far paid Rs. 18,000.00 towards Half yearly payment of Outpatient /Domiciliary treatment for half yearly ending December, 2021.

It is pity that, in spite of implementation of SAP in entire CIL, things have not improved and reimbursement has been delayed for more than 4 months.

We are afraid that, if same pattern continues the things will worsen in future when the half-yearly reimbursement will give way to yearly reimbursement. In such a situation, a delay of 4 months will simply mean that a beneficiary who has borne treatment cost in January,2022 will be reimbursed after 16 months in May,2023. In deed a horrible situation to imagine.

Sir, it is to repeat that financial hardship of retirees is a well-known fact, and this undesirable delay is like putting salt to their injury.

Under the circumstances, your kind intervention is solicited to ensure these reimbursements in all subsidiaries are released centrally at CIL level at the earliest. It is requested for needful advice to the concerned officials to rise up to our expectations and find solution to their problems, if any.
