By expeditiously sanctioning HBA applications in adherence to company regulations, ECL can profoundly enhance the morale of its workforce and uphold the company's pledge to the well-being of its employees. AIACE kindly implores your intervention to ensure that executives receive their House Building Advance benefits in a timely manner.

Furthermore, we appeal to your sense of fairness and equity in addressing the broader issue of executives encountering impediments in accessing various benefits. The streamlining of the benefits disbursement process will not only uplift the spirits of our dedicated workforce but will also contribute substantially to the overall success of ECL.
