Sub: Request for One-time approval and subsequent Minor ammendment in CPRMSE for Cancer patients

Dear Sir,

Our member Sri Gurudhan De, Ex Dy chief Engineer (E&M), Medical Card no CPRMSE/CIL/0794; EIS no. 90062084 had submitted a bill of Rs13116 but, CMO, Coal India paid him only Rs3351 after deduction of Protocol charges of Rs 8000 & some other test charges. (Documents as attached in Annexures).

His claims were submitted under Contributory Post Retirement Medicare Scheme called CPRMS for retired Executives implemented by Coal India Ltd. The provisions of this scheme have undergone various amendments from time to time as per need. Presently, for life-time treatment, there exists a capping of Rs 25 lakh per beneficiary family. However, for critical diseases, they are excluded from this capping and no limit is applicable.

Section 3.2.1 (d) of this scheme specifies the following diseases as Critical diseases:

(i) Heart and Vascular diseases involving surgical or interventional therapy **(ii)** Cancer **(iii)** Renal disease **(iv)** Paralysis **(v)** AIDS & **(vi)** Addison's disease & Adrenal Histoplasmosis.

Further, the above Section outlines the detailed clarification on the treatment of Cancer disease, for which there is no limit, is furnished as below:

(ii) Cancer: This will include (1) cost of Chemotherapy taken at home as prescribed by the concerned Oncologist of notified hospital provided the cost does not exceed the cost of Chemotherapy taken at Indoor or Day Care Centre. (2) cost of investigation for follow up treatment of Cancer patient to evaluate progress and metastasis (may be twice in a year or more) based on advice of the concerned Oncologist of the notified hospital (3) cost of Palliative treatment i.e., end stage treatment of cancer patients at home. Payment may be made on actual basis or on the basis of CGHS approved rate whichever is less.

Based on these clarifications, every beneficiary retiree is confident that CIL will adopt a graceful, sympathetic approach by way of treating the entire treatment cost as admissible, without going into technicality of wordings of the relevant clause. On the basis of this belief, our member Sri Gurudhan De had submitted a bill of Rs13116 but, received only Rs3351.

In anticipation of a liberal view of CIL, we request you for your kind intervention and one-time approval of the entire cost involved for treatment of Cancer in an empaneled hospital, and allow full reimbursement to Sri De. Occurrence of such cases are rare and needful ammendment in CPRMSE scheme is also requested, so that Cancer patients are allowed entire cost of Cancer treatment without any glitch.

You are requested to take necessary action so that I may get the reimbursement of the bill.

I have submitted the bill to Coal India Ltd but CMO ,CIL did not pay the bill .



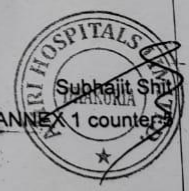
