Sub: Non-payment of Pension, even after lapse of 2 weeks, for January 2025 payable in February, 2025 affecting several pensioners

Dear Sir,

Retired employees of coal industry are beneficiaries of CMPS-1998 pension which is disbursed by your office by way of engaging State Bank of India as the nodal bank which manages nation-wide disbursement with the help of other associated banks.

So far, the payment was more or less being made regularly on the 1st day or in the 1st week of every month.

However, pensioners under CMPS-1998 are facing difficulties and all of them have failed to receive their respective pension for the month of January, 2025 payable in 2025. It is seen that, pension is being released in batches and the process is incomplete even after lapse of 2 weeks in current month.

There is no one to explain the status and reasons leading to this fiasco. Pension paying bank branches are in a fix and unable to provide any solution.

You will agree, Sir, that these ill-paid pensioners are heavily dependent on the paltry pension amount and they are heavily dependent on its timely receipt.

It is requested to take-up this matter with SBI Nodal Bank and ensure immediate release of pension to all and steps are requested such that similar happenings are not repeated in future.
