Dear Sir,

Under CPRMSE & CPRMSNE, CIL and subsidiaries are extending medical facilities to the executives/employees and their spouses in CIL Hospitals along with 400+ odd empanelled hospitals across India.

They are eligible to obtain various types of medical claims under CPRMSE/CPRMSNE either in the form of reimbursement or cashless treatment in empanelled hospitals. We are fully aware of efficiency of Medical and Finance departments and appreciate their vigilant role in ensuring eligible payment as per rules.

It is to bring to your kind notice that the CPRMSE/ NE beneficiaries are not made aware of the residual balances in corpus.

This results in following 3 major problems:

- a. Mental agony of beneficiary who is afraid of drying out of resources reserved for his/her treatment under CPRMSE/CPRMSNE
- b. Delay and Denial in granting approval to empanelled hospitals for providing cashless treatment to beneficiaries
- c. Inability of beneficiaries for changing the company (Subsidiary) for availing CPRMSE/CPRMSNE benefits

It is suggested and requested to ensure intimation of Residual balance of individual corpus after each disbursement under CPRMSE/CPRMSNE.

It is also requested to sensitize medical, HR and finance executives at the ground level to ensure hassle free implementation of the scheme.
