Sub: Inclusion of the name of eligible Divyang Children of CMPS pensioners in Revised PPOs being issued under CMPS-1998 Pension scheme.

Dear Sir,

After the death of the pensioner under CMPS 1998, widow/widower is eligible for pension as per rules. Earlier, these widows/widowers were having painful hurdles in claiming their pension after the death of their respective spouses. After a long drawn struggle, a revised format for Pension Payment Order (PPO) was agreed to be notified for which proper notification was issued on 25th August, 2023 as is clear by the Notification Reference No. CPF/111(26)/Pen/Misc./HQ/Vol-III/520 Dated 25/08/2023 shown in Annexure-I.

This has made the process quite simpler for the beneficiaries as they need not run from pillar to post for starting their legitimate widow/widower pension.

Later on, Divyang Children of pensioners were also brought as beneficiaries under the umbrella of CMPS-1998 vide Gazette Notification no. S.O. 4336(E) dated 4th October, 2023 as shown in Annexure-II.

Unfortunately, boon of simplified process for claim has not been extended to these Divyang children as their names have not been included in the Revised Format.

It is requested that, needful advisory may kindly be issued to CMPFO commissioner to include the name(s) of Divyang children in Revised PPO. These unfortunate children of pensioners are negligible in number and respective pensioners can be easily provided a Revised PPO with inclusion of name(s) of Divyang children.

This small gesture from you end will give immense relief to the pensioners and their Divyang children.

Hoping for an early action from your end.

- Mobile No. of spouse

का.आ. 4336(अ).—केन्द्रीय सरकार, कोयला खान भविष्य निधि और प्रकीर्ण उपबंध अधिनियम, 1948 (1948 का 46) की धारा 7 के साथ पठित धारा 3ड, द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए, कोयला खान पेंशन स्कीम, 1998 में और संशोधन करने के लिए निम्नलिखित स्कीम बनाती है, अर्थात् :-

1. संक्षिप्त नाम और प्रारंभ - (1) इस स्कीम का संक्षिप्त नाम कोयला खान पेंशन (द्वितीय संशोधन) स्कीम, 2023 है।

(2) यह राजपत्र में इसके प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होगी।

2. कोयला खान पेंशन स्कीम, 1998 में पैरा 13 में उप-पैरा (2) के पश्चात् निम्नलिखित उप-पैरा अंतःस्थापित किया जाएगा, अर्थात् :-

“(3) किसी कर्मचारी या पेंशनभोगी की मृत्यु के पश्चात्, यथा स्थिति, उसका/उसकी मृत्यु की तारीख के पश्चात् की तारीख से, ऐसे मृत व्यक्ति के स्थायी रूप से और पूर्ण रूप से दिव्यांग पुत्र या पुत्री, आजीवन या केन्द्रीय सरकार या राज्य सरकार में, नियमित रोजगार प्राप्त करने तक दिव्यांगता पेंशन का हकदार होगा और किसी कर्मचारी या पेंशनभोगी की मृत्यु के पश्चात् देय मासिक दिव्यांगता पेंशन की राशि प्रत्येक यथा स्थिति दिव्यांग पुत्र या पुत्री, के लिए विधवा या विधुर पेंशन की रकम पच्चीस प्रतिशत के बराबर या प्रत्येक दिव्यांग बालक या अनाथ के लिए एक सौ दस रुपये से कम नहीं होगी”।

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 4th October, 2023

S.O. 4336(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3E read with section 7 of the Coal Mines Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1948 (46 of 1948), the Central Government hereby makes the following Scheme further to amend the Coal Mines Pension Scheme, 1998, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**— (1) This scheme may be called the Coal Mines Pension (Second Amendment) Scheme, 2023.

(2) It shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Coal Mines Pension Scheme, 1998, in paragraph 13 after sub-paragraph (2), the following sub-paragraph shall be inserted, namely:-

"(3) After the death of an employee or pensioner, as the case may be, from the date following the date of his or her death, the son or daughter of such deceased person, permanently and totally disabled, shall be entitled to disablement pension till life or until getting regular employment in the Central or State Government, as the case may be, and the amount of monthly disablement pension payable after the death of an employee or pensioner shall be equal to twenty-five per cent. of the amount of widow or widower pension for each disabled son or daughter, as the case may be, or not less than rupees one hundred and ten for each disabled child or orphan".
