Sub: Irregularity in Submission of Life certificates by Pensioners

Several thousand pensioners, spread all over the country, are drawing CMPF pension every month. Every year these pensioners are submitting their respective Life Certificate to their pension paying branches of various banks.

These life certificates are submitted in either of the following 2 modes viz.,

- Old method of Hard copies to their pension paying bank branch
- New digital method using Jeevanpramaan where CMPF is on board

The bank branch in the first mode and CMPF in the second mode are responsible for forwarding these Life certificates to Centralized Pension Processing Cells of respective banks. It is this area where there are a lot of complaints of non-receipt of Life Certificates due to several minor and major reasons.

Result of all this fuss is the ultimate suffering of pensioners who, all of a sudden, are deprived of their monthly earnings for no faults of their own.

Under the circumstances, it is requested that a WARNING system may kindly be incorporated in the pension disbursing mechanism so that a pensioner is intimated at least a month ahead prior to suspension of pension payment.

We at AIACE are sure that with the technologically advanced environment prevailing at CMPF, it is quite easy to implement such a system whereby a simple SMS can be sent to defaulters shown in the records.
