Sub: Request for advising all Regional Commissioners for Ledger Transfer of Executives within 3 months of joining at new place of posting

Dear Sir,

It is a well known fact that executives serving in coal industry of CIL and SCCL are subjected to routine transfers from one place to another place, one subsidiary company to another and also from one colliery unit to other within a company.

These transfers require transfer of CMPF ledgers from one desk to another desk as well as from the office of one Regional Commissioner to another.

Whereas, executives are mostly transferred from one region to another, and rarely within the coverage areas of a particular region, these transfers pose a disaster on the part of executives as their respective CMPF ledgers are not ensured to be moved/transferred to the respective Regional Office corresponding to their new place of postings.

As such, their ledgers are not in a position to be kept updated all along and, at the time of superannuation, settlement of CMPF dues and CMPS-1998 pension becomes a nightmare for the executives.

Under the circumstances, you are requested to advise all Regional Commissioners to take pro-active actions such that, the ledgers of transferred executives are ensured to be transferred to the desired region within a maximum time of 3 months.

This small administrative reform will go a long way to ensure peaceful post-retirement life of an executive who will not be victimized for no fault of his/her own.
